On 6 and 7 June we will host our annual conference on the [Future of Work and Pensions](#).

Automation, the 'gig economy' and demographic change are some of the biggest 'megatrends' that Europe faces and they will have a profound impact on European employees and their pensions. The conference will pose the question how supplementary pensions can continue to play a crucial role in providing adequate, safe and sustainable retirement income in these changing circumstances.
